【独立部分出题规律】

小站机经团队，将 2016 年所有考题，与往年真题进行查重比对，现总结出如下出题规律：

- ◆ 自 2016 年起，独立口语出新题的概率大大增加。新题与旧题各占 50% 左右，且比例相当稳定。每场考试基本以 “一新一旧” 形式出题。新题难度明显加大。独立口语 S1 一定只与历年考试的 S1 重复。同理，S2 也只与历年的 S2 重复，绝不会与任何一道 S1 重复。就重复规律而言，重复前一年北美地区考题的概率最高，因此 2015 年北美考题为复习的重中之重。其次，2013、2014 年大陆的题目命中率也相当高。值得注意的是，“同一道题考过两次就再不会考” 这种说法其实大错特错。相反，2016 年的所有旧题，大部分都重复考过 2 次甚至 3 次以上，几乎没有与 14、15 年新题重复的情况。建议考生着重复习 2015 年北美、2013&2014 年大陆的口语题。
- ◆ 2016 独立写作的新题数量相比去年几乎翻了一番。截止到今天为止的 48 场考试中，有 18 题为新题。30 题为旧题，新旧比例大致为 1:2。三选一类题目增多，共考查 6 次。题目的难度也有所上升，题干长度明显增加。从题材来看，考查最多的依然是 **教育类（17 题）**，其次是 **价值观类（8 题）**。此外，工作类、环境类、活动类、家人朋友类、社会类、政府职能类题目，各占 3-5 题。与往年重复的 28 道旧题中，15 年重复 10 次，14 年 11 次，13 年 3 次，12 和 11 年均均有 2 次。因此同学们可以 **着重复习 15 年和 14 年的题目**。
- ◆ 小范围核心预测（独立版），根据出题规律，精选出 50 道独立口语题和 40 道独立写作题，均为近年来容易考到的高频题。希望大家认真参考，取得理想的成绩！
